Dear Sir,

In reply to your recent letter enquiring about the above named airman, I am sorry to say that no information regarding him is at present available in this office. This is due to the recent developments in the Far East and to the delays inevitable in war-time.

It is understood that the greater part of the Royal Air Force personnel had left Singapore or were evacuated from Malaya before the surrender of the fortress. A list was received of personnel left behind in Singapore and believed to have been taken prisoner of war. This airman's name was not included in this list.

The names of personnel who were safely evacuated from Java to other regions are gradually coming through from various sources. Nominal rolls of such men have been received and are still being received and many of the men have cabled privately to their relatives when in a position to do so.

Considerable delay is being experienced in obtaining the names of such men as were taken prisoner by the Japanese, but it is expected that the names will be received in due course.

In the meantime it is not possible to give you an address to which you may send letters direct. Any letters addressed as follows will, however, be forwarded as soon as practicable:-
